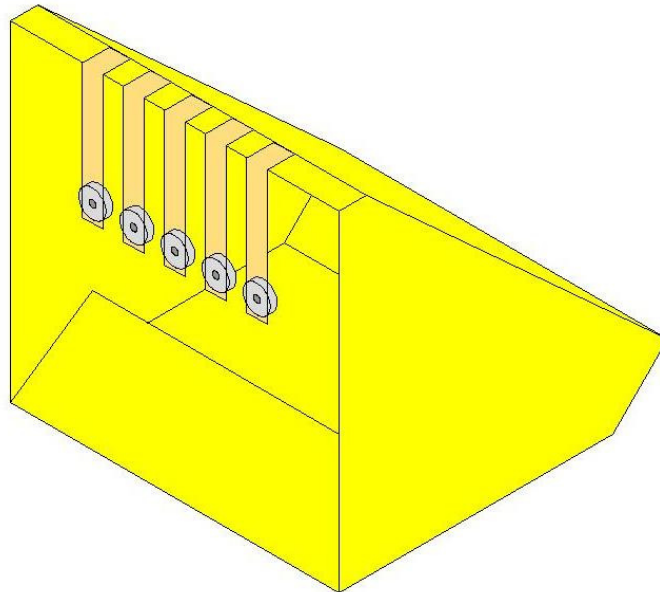


Lifesavers Shooting Accuracy Game

This shooting accuracy game is pretty simple and straight forward.

- 1) Obtain a bag of peppermint Lifesavers. They are white with a hole in the middle, and break easily. Regular fruit flavored Lifesavers don't work so well because small shards that land on the floor can make a sticky mess. The white peppermint Lifesavers don't have this problem.
- 2) A roll of $\frac{3}{4}$ " wide transparent cellophane tape is needed to hang the Lifesavers from a target frame or pellet trap. $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide tape will work, but the wider tape seems to hang better. Five Lifesavers are hung for each shooter, with the tape covering the hole in the Lifesavers as shown.



- 3) Once the targets are set up, shooters are allowed to take 5 shots each, one at each Lifesaver on his or her target stand or pellet trap. Scores are tallied after the five shots are taken.
- 4) Scoring is as follows:
 - a) Hole through the tape, in line with the hole in the Lifesaver. The Lifesaver is NOT broken: 10 points.
 - b) Lifesaver is hit and broken: 1 point
 - c) Wrong Lifesaver is hit: Take away 1 point
 - d) Holes in the tape above the Lifesaver are considered to be a miss, no points.
- 5) As a prize, the winner receives the remaining Lifesavers that are left in the bag at the end of the contest.
